11am Informal

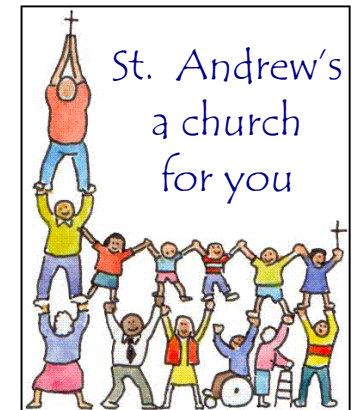
On the 17th of June and the 15th and 29th of July there are 10.15am services in place of the 9.15am and 11am services.
